## 3-Month Junior Trial Memberships

Glenelg Golf Club understands that trying a sport before you commit is important,



which is why we offer a 3-month Junior Trial membership. It's a great way to try the course and practice facilities prior to joining.

Junior Trial membership includes:

- Two (2) lessons with the Club Professional
- Ten (10) small buckets of balls for the Practice Range
- Restricted playing rights.

You can play any time in accordance with Junior Playing Rights during the 3-month Trial Period (except Saturday). You must also have adult supervision or we can arrange supervision for you.

At the end of the 3-month Trial Period, you will be offered Junior membership at the Club.

A membership application fee is required to be eligible for Junior Trial membership. However, if you choose to continue as a

Junior Member, following your 3-month trial, we will deduct that fee from your junior subscription.

### Junior Membership

Junior membership at Glenelg Golf Club offers boys and girls of all levels the chance to play golf at one of Adelaide's most progressive Clubs.

As a new junior member you will receive a 'Junior Member Pack' which includes a range of great items to get you started with your golf at Glenelg Golf Club. You will also find vouchers for discounts and freebies.

### When Can I Play?

Juniors have exclusive rights to the tee on Sunday mornings between 9:30am and 10:00am. This means it's all about you with no adults around!

Juniors can play in every Saturday competition provided they have a handicap of 12 or less. Otherwise, they can play one Saturday competition per month (depending on handicap and skill level) at any time after 1:30pm.

A great range of practice facilities have been designed for you to improve your game. They include a driving range to fine-tune your long game, driving nets, a large practice putting green and a realistic chipping green with challenging bunkers to perfect your short game.

### Junior Competitions

The Club participates in a number of interclub team competitions to give you the opportunity to represent your fantastic Club.

Glenelg Golf Club is involved in two major junior competitions – Junior Pennant and McMillan Shield.

## Junior Development Program – Part of every Junior Membership



**Junior Pennant** – A match play competition held between metropolitan clubs; generally designed for the lower handicap junior golfers.

**McMillan Shield**– A handicap match play competition held between metropolitan clubs. Reserved for the younger, higher handicap junior golfers to give you the experience to reach Junior Pennant.

Opportunities are also given to all juniors to represent the Club by participating in golf trips to country and interstate locations. These are always lots of fun with loads of activities.

### Junior Trips

Are you up for some travelling? We give Junior Members as many opportunities as possible to play golf at other courses and to meet other junior golfers around the State. With a number of day, weekend and three to four day trips during the year, you'll be sure to expand on your golfing experience and have a great time with your golfing mates!

These trips are a great, fun way to make new friends at other clubs and to gain

experience by playing courses other than your own. This gives you the chance to show other junior golfers what you've got!

### What Will it Cost Me?

Junior members pay the entrance fees and annual subscription, plus any required fees and levies.

The entrance fee is payable by yearly installments, negotiated between yourself and the Club, provided that 50% of the total entrance fee is paid by the age of 21 and the remainder by the age of 25.

No entrance fee payment is required in the first year of membership.

### How Do I Join?

Simple! Just fill out a Membership Application Form, which can be collected from the Administration Office at the Club, or downloaded from [www.glenelggolf.com](http://www.glenelggolf.com). This application form needs to be signed by two (2) current playing members of the Club, over the age of 18, and then submitted to the Administration Office.

### Junior Development Program – Part of Every Junior Membership

Our expert coaches, who conduct the Junior Development Program, have a keen eye and recognise that juniors will play at their own level. ### **Committed to Sustainability of Natural Resources**

Glenelg Golf Club aims to achieve a 100% recycled water rating for our course in 2010. We recognise the importance of sustainability.

The project is being successfully managed by our course maintenance team, and overseen by the State Government's Natural Resource Management Board. Funding has been evenly split between the Federal and State Governments and the Club.

Our 1.4 hectare wetlands system is home to more than 50,000 native plants. In addition to this, the Club has commenced a re-vegetation project, identifying areas for extensive native and selected pine tree plantings.

In our commitment to maintaining original landforms and characteristics, we've restored natural sand dunes. The revetted edge bunker, unique to South Australia, is revolutionary in eliminating the sand erosion caused by wind - and adds an extra challenge for golfers.

With a membership at Glenelg Golf Club, you can be assured that your aligning with a club that places a huge premium on the natural environment.
